



# What We Do: A Snapshot of 2023

## **FIELD WORK**

We are on the ground helping communities:

- Support local preservation efforts through our Field Service Program (264 projects in 152 communities)
- Offer technical assistance and support to communities who experienced 2023 July flood damage (32)
- Steward historically significant properties through our Historic Preservation Easement Program (92 easements on 134 buildings, three structures, and three archeological sites)

### **GET PROJECTS STARTED**

We offer small **seed grants** to engage experts to get projects started on the right path:

- Provide project development and technical assistance grants through our Robert Sincerbeaux Fund (43)
- Provide technical assistance grants to owners of historic barns through our Barn Assessment Grant Program (26 barn owners)
- Award funding for special projects through the Paul A. Bruhn Fund (16 projects)

### **NIMBLE SUPPORT**

Through special **initiatives and advocacy** work, we help efforts to build a more vital Vermont:

- Encourage and help develop Community Supported Enterprises such as village stores, cooperatives, restaurants, and community-centered businesses (9 projects)
- Provide technical assistance and capacity building to Vermont's 24 designated downtowns to preserve historic character, economic vitality, and prevent sprawl.
- Advocate for funding Vermont's Village and Downtown Tax Credit program as well as the Better Places program for "placemaking" projects in designated centers.

### **MAJOR SUPPORT**

When resources are available, we provide **major support** for places important to Vermonters:

- Award grants to projects in Vermont's Northeast Kingdom in partnership with the Freeman Foundation (seven)
- Award grants for preservation projects in Rutland County in partnership with the Johnson Family Foundation (three)
- Award grants to rural Vermont communities through Paul Bruhn Historic Revitalization grant program (seven)
- Award grants for preservation projects in partnership with the 1772 Foundation (14)
- Award grants for preservation projects in Bennington and Rutland counties through the Southern Vermont Fund (five)
- Manage major grants for projects awarded in previous years

## **EDUCATION & TRAINING**

Through **gatherings and partnerships**, we share knowledge and expertise:

- Co-host the first Village Meet-up in Strafford (106 individuals from 53 communities)
- Host Preservation Retreats from May through October (47 individuals from 37 communities)
- Distribute a monthly newsletter and special e-alerts for urgent issues
